Boulder Junction Public Library Board of Trustees Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting Thursday, June 13, 2019 – 4 pm

Call to Order: Johnson called the meeting to order at 4:03 pm.

Roll Call of Members: Members present were Sue Fehlandt, Eric Johnson, Ellen Murphy Blank, and Mary Van Grinsven (late with notice). Sara Fieweger was absent with notice. Library Director, Cherie Sanderson, was also present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Recognition of Visitors/Comments: No visitors in attendance.

Agenda Approval: Motion by Murphy Blank to approve the agenda as presented with the Chair's discretion to move the order of items on the agenda. Motion seconded by Fehlandt. Motion carried.

Minutes Approval: Motion by Fehlandt to approve the May 14, 2019 minutes. Motion seconded by Murphy Blank. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Financial Report: Fehlandt presented the May monthly report and the Year-to-Date financial report. End of May balance for the Checking Account is \$26,945.57 with \$2,702.52 segregated for the Reading Garden. End of May balance in the Hybrid Checking Account is \$10,874.18. Total funds available to the board at the end of May are \$37,819.75. Motion by Murphy Blank to place the report on file for audit. Motion seconded by Johnson. Motion carried.

Audit and Approval of Bills and Credit Card Transactions: Sanderson reviewed the bills to be paid. Bills to be paid by the library board total \$1,545.50. Bills to be paid by the Town total \$858.30. Bills already paid by the Town total \$6,688.31. Bills to be paid by the Friends total \$981.52. Bills to be paid from the Reading Garden Fund total \$649.00. Motion by Murphy Blank to approve payment of the bills and credit card. Motion seconded by Fehlandt. Motion carried.

Discussion and Possible Action on Adding Agendas to the Library Website: Currently the agendas are listed under events and are archived. No action taken to change current procedures.

Board/Director Goal – Operations Calendar: Van Grinsven explained that we are building the calendar as we go through the year and that it will be an ongoing process. No action taken.

Milwaukee Journal Discussion and Possible Approval: Sanderson explained that we cannot obtain a subscription in the mail and the closest retail outlet to purchase the paper is in Minocqua. Sanderson did an informal poll of patrons who requested the paper and only a few asked. Due to the lack of demand and the complications, we will not obtain the paper.

Reading Garden Update – Sign Location and Fence Approval: Van Grinsven has picked up the Donor sign and it has been paid in full. Dennis Reuss gave us the go-ahead to build and install 2-sided fences around the Generator and Electric boxes. We need to find a construction person to build and install the fences. We would then attach the donor sign to one of the fences. Ken Middleton will come consult with us on what to do with replacing dead shrubs and plants.

Art Committee Update and Approval of Future Exhibits: No new exhibits to approve. Jeff Trapp is the July exhibit. 2nd Annual Juried Show is the August exhibit. The juried show is being judge by Susie Govier and Leah

Trojan. Juried Show Artist's Reception and Prize Awards will be held on Friday, August 2 from 4-5:30 pm. September show is the Knitting/Craft Club. October show will be offered to the winner of the Juried Show.

Set Date and Time for Next Meeting: The next regular meeting will be held on Thursday, July 11 at 4 pm. The August meeting will be held on Thursday, August 15 at 4 pm.
