Boulder Junction Public Library Board of Trustees Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting Thursday, October 15, 2020 – 4:00 pm

Call to Order: Murphy Blank called the meeting to order at 4:00 pm. The meeting was held in the library, as well as virtually on the BlueJeans video and teleconference platform to protect our community from Covid-19.

Roll Call of Members: Members present were Sue Fehlandt, Sara Fieweger (arrived late due to work), Ellen Murphy Blank, Maggie Wolf, and Mary Van Grinsven. Library Director, Cherie Sanderson, was also present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Recognition of Visitors/Comments: No visitors were present either in person or online.

Murphy Blank accepted the reports to be placed on file for audit.

Audit and Approval of Bills and Credit Card Transactions: Sanderson reviewed the bills to be paid. Bills to be paid by the library board total \$0. Bills to be paid by the Town total \$0. Bills already paid by the Town total \$4,767.81. Bills to be paid by the Friends total \$2,937.05. Motion by Wolf to approve payment of the bills as presented. Motion seconded by Fehlandt. Motion carried.
