Call to Order: Murphy Blank called the meeting to order at 3:01 pm.

Roll Call of Members: Members present were Sara Fieweger, Nancy Harvey, Ellen Murphy Blank, Laura Sass, and Mary Van Grinsven. Library Director, Cherie Sanderson, was also present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Recognition of Visitors/Comments: None.

Agenda Approval: Motion by Van Grinsven to approve the agenda as presented with the Chair's discretion to move the order of items on the agenda. Motion seconded by Harvey. Motion carried.

Minutes Approval: Motion by Van Grinsven to approve the July 19, 2022 regular meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Harvey. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Financial Report: Harvey presented the July monthly report and the Year-to-Date financial report. End of July balance for the "5311" Checking Account is \$30,737.82 with \$3,581.64 segregated for the Reading Garden. End of July balance in the "Non-Profit 1012" Checking Account is \$16,976.19 Total funds available to the board at the end of July are \$46,023.76. Murphy Blank accepted the reports to be placed on file for audit.

Audit and Approval of Bills and Credit Card Transactions: Sanderson reviewed the bills to be paid. Bills to be paid by the library board total \$328.46. Bills to be paid by the Town total \$106.15. Bills already paid by the Town total \$2,477.84. Bills to be paid by the Friends total \$1,426.90. Motion by Sass to approve payment of the bills as presented including the Marco bill when it arrives. Motion seconded by Harvey. Motion carried.

Prizes were purchased from Imaginuity, and I will be asking the Friends to reimburse for those prizes as they have done almost every year. With Jessica resigning, the after-school reading program plans are unknown at this time.

<u>Adult Programming Update:</u> Books clubs, Knitting, Mah Jongg, and Northern Waters Genealogy continue to meet. Programming is winding down but there are still programs throughout this month and there may be some added in September.

<u>Computers/Technology Update:</u> I have ordered two new computers with the NWLS fall group purchase. One will replace a very old and unreliable computer #4 and one will replace the circ desk computer. Princh was moved from the Pharos/Catalog computer to the Circ desk and we are having no more issues. We have not had any request for the hotspots yet.
