## Boulder Junction Public Library Board of Trustees Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting July 13, 2023 – 4 pm

**Call to Order:** Murphy Blank called the meeting to order at 4:02 pm.

**Roll Call of Members:** Members present were Ellen Murphy Blank, Lanette Nelson, Laura Sass and Mary Van Grinsven. Nancy Harvey was absent with notice. Library Director, Cherie Sanderson, was also present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

**Recognition of Visitors/Comments**: None present.

**Agenda Approval**: Motion by Van Grinsven to approve the agenda as presented with the Chair's discretion to move the order of items on the agenda. Motion seconded by Nelson. Motion carried.

**Election of Officers:** Motion by Van Grinsven to approve the slate of officers as presented: Murphy Blank, President; Van Grinsven, Vice-President; Harvey, Treasurer; Sass, Secretary; and Nelson, Member-at-Large. Motion seconded by Nelson. Motion carried.

**Minutes Approval**: Motion by Van Grinsven to approve the June 8, 2023 regular meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Murphy Blank. Motion carried.

**Treasurer's Financial Report**: Harvey presented the June monthly reports and the Year-to-Date financial report (via email before the meeting). End of June balance for the "5311" Checking Account is \$41,344.19 with \$3,371.94 segregated for the Reading Garden. End of June balance in the "Non-Profit 1012" Checking Account is \$17,294.48. Total funds available to the board at the end of June are \$56,379.40. Murphy Blank accepted the reports to be placed on file for audit.

Audit and Approval of Bills and Credit Card Transactions: Sanderson reviewed the bills to be paid. Bills to be paid by the library board total \$398.88. Bills to be paid by the Town total \$0. Bills already paid by the Town total \$4,912.09. Bills to be paid by the Friends total \$1,926.18. Motion by Sass to approve payment of the bills as presented with the Marco bill to be paid when it arrives. Motion seconded by Van Grinsven. Motion carried.

Director's Monthly Report (taken directly from the report handed out at the meeting): <u>Circulation and Usage Statistics:</u> See attached report.

<u>Friends of the Library Update:</u> The Friends of the Library met on Wednesday, July 12 at 8:30 am in the Reading Room. The Wine & Beer Tasting event is being re-branded as a "Taste of Boulder Junction" event which means tastes/samples of food and drink from local restaurants and stores. There will still be the usual basket raffle and silent auction too. Tickets sales will be limited to 100 at \$30 per ticket. The Used Book Sale is doing well but is down from last year.

<u>Children's Programming Updates:</u> Weekly Children's Reading Program is going well. Attendance varies each week, but the kids participating in the reading challenge are turning in their logs and reading a LOT! First movie night had low attendance – hoping for bigger turnout this month. Little Free Library is up at the park but needs signage. Book Walk will hopefully be installed this weekend. Book Bike has only made it to two Music on Main events so far but gave away over 30 children's books already.

Adult Programming Update: Books Clubs, Knitting, Mah Jongg, Music Collective, and Northern Waters Genealogy meet regularly. The Summer Passport program and "Check Out Wisconsin State Parks at Your Library" program are both up and running. We've handed out and stamped a lot of passports already! Only had one state park pass go out so far. There are a lot of summer programs, and more being added later in August, September, and October.

NWLS/NWLN Updates: NWLN/NWLS sub committees continue to meet. Nothing new to report.

**Friends of the Library Wish List Update:** Name tags are still on hold because he is too busy right now. After things slow down, we need to revisit our Wish List and start to compile new needs.
