Boulder Junction Public Library Board of Trustees Minutes of the Regular Board Meeting June 12, 2025 – 4:00 pm

Call to Order: Vice-President Laura Sass called the meeting to order at 4:01 pm.

Roll Call of Members: Members present were Dennis Aukstik, Nancy Harvey, Lanette Nelson and Laura Sass.

Library Director, Cherie Sanderson, was also present and kept the minutes of the meeting.

Children's Program Assistant/Library Assistant, Kate Frisk, was also present.

Recognition of Visitors/Comments: Herman Peterson was present as a guest and candidate for the Board of Trustees vacancy.

Agenda Approval: Motion by Aukstik to approve the agenda as presented with the Chair's discretion to move the order of items on the agenda. Motion seconded by Harvey. Motion carried.

Appoint Interim President: Motion by Aukstik to appoint Sass as Interim President until officers are elected at the July board meeting. Motion seconded by Harvey. Motion carried.

Minutes Approval: Motion by Aukstik to approve the May 8, 2025 regular meeting minutes. Motion seconded by Harvey. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Financial Report: Harvey presented the May Treasurer's Reports. The balance in the "5311" checking account at the end of May was \$27,667.25. The balance in the "1012" account at the end of May was \$18,571.44. The balance in Reading Garden designated funds at the end of May was \$2,473.94. The balance of the CD at the end of May was \$25,195.68. Total funds held by the board at the end of May is \$71,434.37. Harvey explained the new file format for the report which includes the new CD. Sass accepted the report to be placed on file for audit.

Audit and Approval of Bills and Credit Card Transactions: Sanderson reviewed the bills to be paid. Bills to be paid by the library board total \$1931.78. Bills to be paid by the Town total \$120.04. Bills already paid by the Town total \$6934.36. Bills to be paid by the Friends total \$2160.71. Motion by Aukstik to approve payment of the bills as presented with payment to Marco when the statement is received. Motion seconded by Nelson. Motion carried.

<u>Friends of the Library Update:</u> The Used Book Sale was rained out the first week but had an amazing 2nd week. They have inventory in two storage sheds now. Lauren is tweaking the Taste of Boulder Junction auction/raffles

and will announce the changes soon. The next meeting of the Friends is Wednesday, July 9 at 8:30am in the library.

Children's Programming Updates: Lighted Schoolhouse ended on June 2nd. We had 7 students total with the last one being added in the last two weeks of the program. Music on Main started yesterday, June 11 - Kate and Cherie can give a verbal report on the numbers. The Summer Library Program will begin next Wednesday and we are already getting messages about it! Kate (and Drew) have run into a few hiccups trying to set up the Great Reading Challenge website so we will be returning to paper tracking this year and will focus on the website after summer for future use. Kate is also in talks with The Little Forest School about making a few visits there this summer after they start up - this would most likely continue throughout the year as well. Talks are also continuing with Callie from Manitowish Waters about more future combined programming opportunities aside from the upcoming scheduled science and dragon programs. There will also be talks after summer about a possible Renaissance Faire hosted by several Vilas County Libraries in a combined effort.

<u>Adult Programming Updates:</u> Programming is underway. We are not doing as much as last year but still have a full schedule. See listing below. More authors may be added. Digital Services classes in May had very, very low turnout. Vilas County ADRC sessions have had fair turnouts.

NWLS/NWLN Updates: Jackee Johnson's position is still not being filled. I will continue to forward emails with updates about IMLS funding and how that affects state and system funding/cuts.
